

AFFILIATION AND RECOGNITION





B.Sc. Nursing is a 4 year undergraduate full time programme comprising eight semesters focused on developing critical care, advanced thinking skills proficiency and values necessary for the practice of professional Nursing and Midwifery. As per the Indian Nursing Council, the course is offered under the choice based credit system (CBCS) The revised curriculum embraces competency based approach throughout the program integrating mastery learning and self-directed learning students are provided with opportunities to learn a whole range of nursing skills in addition to acquiring knowledge related to nursing practice. This is achieved thorough learning in skill lab/simulated labs and clinical environment semester examination will be conducted in both theory and practical by West Bengal University of Health Science as Prescribed by INC,



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st december of the year in which admission is sought and upper age limit no bar.
- candidate must have passed the class 10+2 examination with physics, chemistry and biology (PCB) and English from recognized board with secure an aggregate of 45% and for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B/PWD candidates with 40%
- candidates found guilty of misconduct or convicted for any offence shall not be eligible for admission.
- candidates should be medically fit.
- candidate should be a citizen of India.



GNM or General Nursing Midwifery is a three-year diploma course designed for aspirants pursuing a career in clinical nursing. The GNM curriculum prepares students to serve as competent member of the healthcare team, starting with skill for first level positions in all types of healthcare organizations. The scheme is designed to enable quality applicants to address the health needs of the individuls community and country. They can also pursue advanced study and expertise in nursing while contributing to the health-based industry with patience, responsibility and commitment.



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Candidate for admission GNM should have passed 10+2 with English as one subject and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually for any recognized board.
- Candidates are eligible with registered ANM with pass mark.
- Candidates 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational stream health care sciences from a recognized board, ANM course from the school recognized by INDIAN NURSING COUNCIL.
- The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st december of the year in which admission is sought and upper age limit no bar.
- Candidates shall be medically fit for the course.


COMPUTER LAB

Rules & Regulations of the Institution

- 1. All students are required to be punctual and are not allowed to miss classes without genuine reason and without prior permission from the Principal of the institution.
- 2. Students must comply with the rules and regulations formed by the Institution.
- 3. Students must be in recommended uniforms in the clinics, community and in the classroom.
- 4. Students should participate and take initiative for leadership in professional and social activities.
- 5. No visitor, mobile phones are allowed during classes as well as duty hours. In case of any emergency, guardians are allowed to inform the Principal.
- 6. 100% attendance is mandatory for all clinical experience. Hence make-up of duty is compulsory for any absence in the Clinical Field.
- 7. Vacation will be granted by the institution as per regulation of West Bengal Nursing Council, Kolkata.
- 8. Students having sickness while on leave must inform the Principal on the same day.
- 9. Sick students are not allowed to stay in the hostel without permission of the institution.
- 10. Fees once submitted are not refundable.
- 11. Each student is responsible to pay all the examination fees and fees for special clinical exposure as per course curriculum.
- 12.In case of discontinuation of the course by the student the payments already made shall be forfeited.
- 13. During the training period, in case of any unforeseen Health Problem requiring hospitalization or surgical intervention, would be on the students own expenditure & during that period the Presence of either of the parents/local guardian is mandatory.


Rules & Regulations of the Hostel

- 1. The students of the accommodation shall about by the instructions and directions of the Hostel incharge/Warden.
- 2. It is mandatory to reside in the hostel provided by the institution.
- 3. Students are not allowed to keep any valuables like jewellery in the hostel. Students are solely responsible for their personal belongings.
- 4. Students are requested to stay in the hostel as a family and solve their problems within the hostel.
- 5. Hostel articles must be returned at the time of final departure from the hostel. After that clearance will be given and caution money will be returned to the student.
- 6. Room shall be allocated by the Hostel in-charge and no personal preference will be entertained.
- 7. Overall cleanliness of the room is to be maintained by he students residing in the hostel.
- 8. No sticker to be removed on walls.
- 9. No furniture to be removed from the room.
- 10. Fans & Lights are to be switched off before leaving the rooms.
- 11.Rooms must be kept arranged & tidy.



- 12. Avoid using garments & articles of other students.
- 13. Visitors are not allowed in student's rooms.
- 14. Students' own mobile phones (if any) are to be kept under lock & key before coming to duties/classes and can be taken back at the time of evening attendance in the hostel.
- 15. Visitors are allowed only on Sunday (10am-5pm).
- 16.One overnight pass will be issued per month. Night passes will be issued only on the guardian's address. class representatives should report to the Hostel-in-Charge for night pass after obtaining signature from respective teacher previous day of night pass.
- 17. Students should maintain the 'Meal Register' for not taking hostel meals.
- 18. Students are allowed to make any outgoing calls from the institutional phone.
- 19. Any candidate involved in ragging will be punished according to the law, including expulsion from the institution or imprisonment up to 3 years or fine of Rs.25,000/- or all the aforementioned.
- 20. No students are allowed to come out from their room in nightdress.
- 21. Any student falling sick should report to the Hostel in-Charge.
- 22. The Hostel in-Charge will be escorting the sick student to the hospital & get checked up by the Doctor.
- 23. Students are asked to spread their wet clothes only on the designated place not elsewhere.
- 24. Strict action will be taken against the students if rules violated.
- 25. Serious desciplinary action will be taken against the student from the hostel without any information.
- 26. Regular night attendance will be maintained by the Hostel in-charge.

Anti-Ragging



According to the Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act. 1998, 'ragging' means doing of any act by disorderly conduct to a student of an educational institution, which causes or likes to cause physical or Psychological harm or raising apprehension or shame or embarrassment to student and includes teasing or abusing or playing practice jokes or causing hurt to such student or asking a student to do any act or to perform something which such students will not in the ordinary course be willing to do. All institution will have

to abide by the directives of the Honourable Supreme Court of India. Dated May 16, 2007 in SLP No. (s) 24295 of 2006 University of Kerala Vs. Council Principal's Colleges, Kerala Ors. (with SLP(C) No. 24296-99/2004 and WP (Crl.) No. 173/2006&SLP (C) No. 14356/2005] and the recommendations approved by the Honourable Supreme Court of India on effective Prevention of ragging in educational institutions. In case the applicant for admission is found to have indulged in ragging in the past or if it is noticed later he/she shall be expelled from the educational institutions. Each of the students of the institution and his/her parents or guardian are required to submit a combined undertaking at the registration/admission in the prescribed format available in Annexure II which is mandatory for registration/admission.
